JOURNAL REPORT OF UNIT 1 BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING September 16, 2025

The Homeowners' Board held a meeting on Tuesday, September 16, 2025 with 7 board members, 45 residents, and Joe Polkowski, Property Manager, in attendance.

Following are the major points of board members' reports:

Treasurer/Alterations Director Bob Helmick

An update was given on the operating and reserve accounts. At our May 2025 meeting, delinquencies totaled \$8,624; as of August 31, 2025, delinquencies have risen to \$12,961. There are five homeowners that are in arrears over \$1,000 each with one in particular in arrears \$4,400. They are all with our association attorney for collection/foreclosure, and will also incur late fees and attorney fees.

Since our last meeting, there have been 45 alteration requests.

Director of Clubhouse/Rec Area Roger Rice

Over the summer months, we were able to accomplish everything we talked about at our May meeting. The clubhouse floor was polished; carpet in the library and office was replaced with vinyl plank flooring; the

face of the marquee was replaced; partitions in the rest rooms were replaced.

Bingo donated \$5,000 to pay for the partitions in the women's rest room. Without their generosity, it would have been another year before this was done.

Director of Roofs Barbara Schwendenman

During the months of May-August 2025, 14 tile roofs were replaced as follows: Four had leaks, one failed inspection, and nine were past their life span. Two flat roofs were replaced as follows: One failed inspection and one had leaks.

Director of Lawns Jim Toothill

Between September 2024 and August 2025, we logged 18 complaints regarding lawn mowing of which 7 were follow-ups. For the same time period, we had 21 complaints regarding Tri-S lawn treatment of which 2 were follow-ups. This is down from 46 complaints last year which shows the treatments are working.

Message from Your Board

Starting now through hurricane season, the lakes will be kept one foot lower than normal to help deal with the heavy rainfall and, if needed, to get a head start on draining the lakes if a storm is approaching.

Regarding the gates, the manufacturer in Miami believes they have found the hardware issue on the motherboard. It will be reinstalled on Wednesday, September 17, and hopefully the problem will finally be fixed.

There have been reports of people throwing bags of dog waste down the storm drains. Please don't do that.

Painting for this year has been completed and will resume next year.

Depending on funds in the painting account, Dot and I will discuss cleaning roofs that are exceptionally dirty. We're looking at something that can be done from the ground, and will be testing that shortly.

The water leak at 45th Street and 94th Terrace will be addressed in the next week. We've been testing ways to isolate the line so not too many homes will be affected by a water shutoff. It is a small leak so there is no danger of the road collapsing.

As far as the proposed budget which is not yet approved, there would be a **3.84%** increase in maintenance fees for a partially funded budget.

NEW BUSINESS

Our Property Manager, Joe Polkowski, gave a brief explanation regarding the reason for the following item:

At the September 17, 2024 board meeting, a motion was made, seconded and approved to allow backyard fencing. Since this item was not on the agenda, it is considered an invalid motion. Unless it is an emergency, any motion made at a board meeting must be on the agenda. In order to correct the error, the meeting minutes need to be amended to remove the invalid motion regarding fencing.

A motion was made by Dot Muller seconded by Jim Toothill to amend the September 17, 2024 minutes to remove the invalid motion.

The board was polled and the motion passed.



Left- Right- Center Tournament Rules

Left Center Right (LCR) Dice Game This is a popular game played with chips (or coins) and special dice.

- Objective: To be the last player with chips.
- Setup: Each player starts with a set number of chips (e.g., three).
- On Your Turn:
 - Roll the dice: You roll the number of dice equal to the number of chips you currently have.

New Sales Tax Exemptions Beginning August 1, 2025

Effective August 1, 2025, the following items, which have been temporarily exempted during past tax holidays, are always exempt:

Batteries - only sizes specified below are exempt:

- AA-cell
- AAA-cell
- C-cell
- D-cell
- 6-volt
- 9-volt

Bicycle helmets – Youth bicycle helmets were previously exempt; all bicycle helmets are exempt beginning August 1, 2025.

Carbon monoxide alarms - As defined in section 553.885, Florida Statutes (F.S.), "carbon monoxide alarm" means a device that is meant for the purpose of detecting carbon monoxide, that produces a distinct audible alarm, and that meets the requirements of and is approved by the Florida Building Commission.

Fire extinguishers – As defined in s. 633.102, F.S., "fire extinguisher" means a cylinder that:

- (a) Is portable and can be carried or is on wheels.
- (b) Is manually operated.
- (c) May use a variety of extinguishing agents that are expelled under pressure.
- (d) Is rechargeable or nonrechargeable.
- (e) Is installed, serviced, repaired, recharged, inspected, and hydrotested according to applicable procedures of the manufacturer. standards of the National Fire Protection Association, and the Code of Federal Regulations.
- (f) Is listed by a nationally recognized testing laboratory.

Ground anchor systems and tie-down kits

Insect repellent – products registered by the US Environmental Protection Agency which are designed to deter insects and are intended for application to the skin of a person

Life jackets – personal flotation device approved by the US Coast Guard intended to be worn by a person to provide buoyancy to support a person in the water

Portable gas cans - portable gas or diesel fuel cans with a capacity of 5 gallons or less

Portable generators – portable engine-driven generators capable of producing 10,000 running watts or less

Smoke detection devices - As defined in s. 83.51, F.S., "smoke detection device" means an electrical or battery-operated device which detects visible or invisible particles of combustion and which is listed by Underwriters Laboratories, Inc., Factory Mutual Laboratories, Inc., or any other nationally recognized testing laboratory using nationally accepted testing standards.

Sunscreen - excludes cosmetics or other products that are not primarily intended to absorb, reflect, or scatter ultraviolet radiation

Waterproof tarpaulins – flexible waterproof tarps and sheeting that are 1,000 square feet or less
