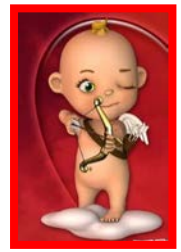

*By now you will have received a letter asking you to vote for the purchase of our Clubhouse. We hope you have returned your proxies and more importantly voted **YES** for UNIT 2's opportunity of a lifetime. We have scheduled a Board Meeting for February 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. at the Unit 2 Clubhouse to approve the sale. Please attend this important meeting. **IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED YOUR PROXY – CALL ME AT (727) 578-2341 AND WE WILL BRING YOU ONE.***

In the near future, you will be asked to vote on a very important issue affecting our community. We will be distributing ballots asking you to make a decision regarding "GATING THE MAINLANDS". The City of Pinellas Park has already approved over 500 condo/apartment units to be constructed with 300 more in the planning stages near our Community. The Park/Gandy reconstruction which could take two years to complete is certain to add to our pass thru traffic problems. There are many benefits to gating the community.

- It will significantly cut down on the amount of traffic damage to our roadways, curbs and sidewalks. There is less potential for vehicle to vehicle and vehicle to pedestrian accidents.
- It would mean an immediate increase in home values.
- Potential for reduced crime due to the perception that Mainlands' is a closed private community.
- Video cameras will pick up all license plates of people entering and exiting the complex.
- One remote to open and close the gates will be given to each homeowner. It will become part of the home and must be conveyed with the home when it is sold. Anyone needing a second would be at their expense.

*There are no disadvantages to gating 40<sup>th</sup> Street or 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue that would adversely affect our residents. Please take the safety of our residents seriously that reside on the five streets affected in Unit 2 with your vote.*

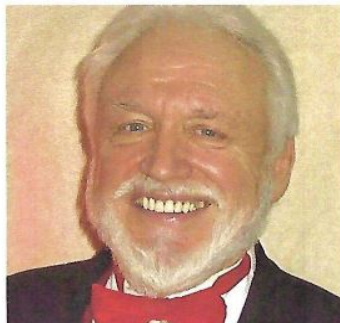

We had a major sidewalk and curb replacement project last year. Since 2014, we have spent approximately \$150,000 making these repairs. On any typical day, it is not uncommon to see at least a half dozen vehicles illegally parked on the sidewalks. If we do not take necessary action to curb this practice, we may need to raise the monthly maintenance fees to keep up with repairs.

We are now taking aggressive action in telling the offenders to please respect our property. Do not park on grass and sidewalks signs have been recently installed at the primary entrances to our unit. We are ticketing these offenders and placing a copy of the citation in the home owners file. We have the legal right to have these vehicles towed from the property and we intend to exercise this if it becomes necessary.

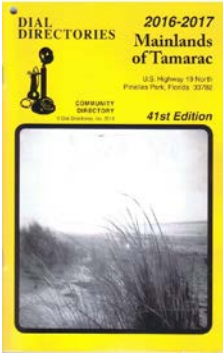
