The family moved to Connecticut where her father bought a little farm. Then the depression hit!! Everyone who could find a job worked. Anne worked in a Button Factory and stayed there until the beginning of World War II.

Anne moved to Hartford, CT to work in a factory making parts for planes, etc. The war effort was on. After the war she worked in retail and got married in 1956. They had no children.

After her husband passed away in 1976, she traveled a lot – her most memorable trip was an 18-day cruise to Europe including the Holy Land and Turkey. She then went to work for United Bank of Hartford until she retired in 1983.

Anne moved to Florida and eventually to Mainlands Unit 2 in 2003 at age 86. She echoes what everyone says that lives here. It's a great place to live.

**TAXPAYERS BARRAGED BY SCAM PHONE CALLS
Excerpts from: KATHY KRISTOF MONEYWATCH March 12, 2018**



Tax scam calls have soared 1,218 percent since last year, inundating American taxpayers with often threatening calls in the name of the Internal Revenue Service.

Scammers use multiple methods to trick victims out of their money, according to Hiya, a phone spam protection company that analyzed the growth in tax scam calls made in January and February of this year versus 2017. The most common con involves telling the victim that they're under investigation for tax fraud and that they'll be arrested if they don't pay a bogus back tax bill immediately.

If you get a phone call from someone claiming to be from the IRS, take note: The agency will never initiate a phone call to a taxpayer, unless they're returning your call.
