CHANGES TO THE SOCIAL CLUB BY-LAWS TO BE VOTED ON MARCH 11TH, 2020

The Social Club Officers and Directors are beginning to make changes to the By-Laws. These changes are necessary to have a better functioning committee which operates on your behalf. These changes will take place over the next year and will not take effect without approval by you the membership. Each change will be announced to the membership at the monthly membership meeting held the 2nd Wednesday of the month after Kaffee Klatch. The changes will then be posted on the Clubhouse information Board for 30 days, then voted on by the membership. If passed, the changes will go into effect immediately. Below is a draft of the present changes brought to the membership on January 8th, 2020 and which will be voted on March 11th, 2020. The Social Club Officers and Directors are beginning to make changes to the By-Laws - Specifically:

✦ ARTICLE IV:

✓ FINANCING:

- ~~Strike –Income shall be generated exclusively from transfer interview and other approved sources.~~ Replace with: *Income shall be generated exclusively from transfer interview and services as approved by the Board.*

✓ EXPENDITURES:

- ~~Strike – The President shall approve any and all cash expenditures of two hundred or less (\$250.00).~~ Replace with: *The President shall approve any and all cash expenditures of five hundred dollars or less (\$500.00).*
- ~~Strike – The Board of Directors shall approve and authorize the expenditures of funds not in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).~~ Replace with: *The Board of Directors shall approve and authorize the expenditures of funds not in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).*
- ~~Strike - The Members shall approve and authorize the expenditure of funds in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).~~ Replace with: *The Members shall approve and authorize the expenditure of funds in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).*

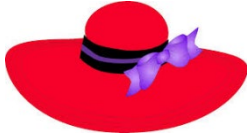


STAY OFF OF THE ROOF

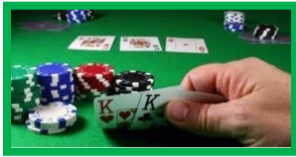

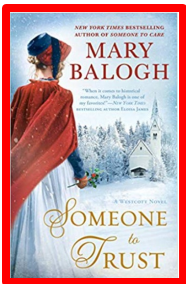
PINOCHLE

Sally Kruse

I was born in Tampa, Florida – the last of nine children – AKA the baby. I had two children by the time I was 20 (they are my biggest blessing) became a grandmother at 35 and great-grandmother at 55 (total of six grandchildren and six great- grandchildren). I had various jobs – everything from running an elevator to smelling chicken to see if they were rotten before I put them out to sell. Won't mention the grocery store, but I wouldn't buy any roasted chickens from any of them. I sold real estate, insurance, appliances and furniture, before finding my true profession.

I met Gerry in 1971, (her profile was in the October issue of the **TOWN CRIER**) and she convinced me to get out of sales and get a real job after all I was getting old and needed retirement benefits (I was 39). It took a while, but finally in 1979 I got a job as a clerk typist at the Museum of Science & Industry in Tampa (Civil Service).

Two year later (1981), I applied for a transfer and was hired at Tampa General Hospital as a Tumor Registrar. The only qualification was that you had to have passed the typing test. I had no medical background and barely passed the typing test. Florida had just passed a law that all cancer cases were reportable to the state. No one knew the job or how to do it. We all had to be trained – in the beginning we had to fill out a 5 x 7 card and type basic information and send to the State (now it's 21 pages on a computer).

In 1983 a Tumor Registrar Certification test was given – I wasn't eligible until 1984 and passed the test and became a Certified Tumor Registrar (CTR). I was elected as President of the Florida Cancer Registrars Association (twice) and President of the National Cancer Registrar Association. Also held multiple positions in both Associations and Distinguished Member of both. In 1995 went to work in Customer Service for a Cancer Registrar's software company and still work part-time with them.

Gerry and I moved to Mainlands in 2000 and we absolutely love it here. I've served on the Board multiple years with various positions – due to Gerry's and my sister, Ethel's, medical problems I had to resign from the Board. I am the editor of the **TOWN CRIER** and really enjoy it. I think everyone should find a place to live as good as Mainlands. Other than my children, Mainlands is the biggest blessing I ever received.

Extra players are welcome and can be rotated in the game easily. No experience needed, and everyone is encouraged to come play or just cheer on your favorite team.

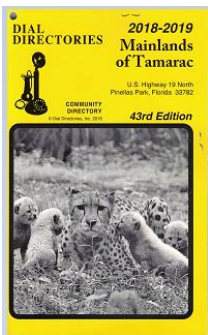
