As announced previously, our pool will be shut down for approximately one month starting March 9th. The pool surface and the piping in the pit will be completely redone at this time. Arrangements have been made with Unit 1 for our residents to use their pool. Please read and follow their posted rules.

We have had multiple violations of dog owners throwing their dog excrement into the storm drains. Not only does the dog poop cause excessive weed growth, the plastic bag does not disintegrate and can cause great distress to the wildlife inhabiting our lakes.

We will soon be contracting with a street sweeping company to clean our roads on a periodic schedule. We will try to tie this in with lawn mowing. Speaking of streets – *we want to thank Debbie & Jerry Smith for planting the flowers by the Unit 2 signs. They are beautiful!*

If you have attended the Master Association meetings, you know we have been looking for a suitable location for our Mainlands Office that would enable us to own the land and building. The current location has been rented far too long and we have spent well over One Million Dollars with nothing to show for it. The attorney outlined what steps each Unit will need to take in order to facilitate the sale (and subsequent purchase). This will require resident approval, and we hope to have something for your review within the next 30- 45 days. Neither the sales contract nor the specifics for resident voting have been nailed down yet, so there is limited information to share. As things crystalize, your Board will provide more detailed information. We thank you, as always, for your interest and support.

UPCOMING EVENTS: Summer will be upon us soon and the Social Club is busy working on some events to keep us entertained thru the long hot summer months. More to follow on this.

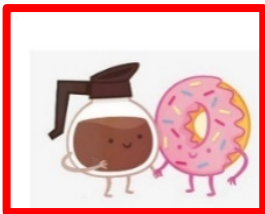

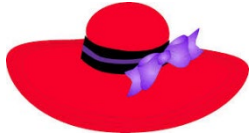

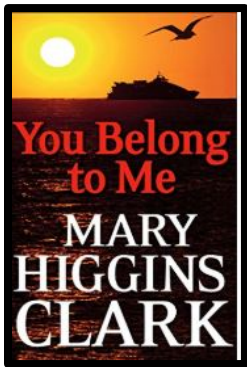
WINNERS OF THE TEXAS HOLD'EM TOURNAMENT

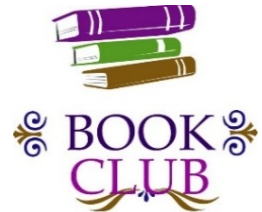

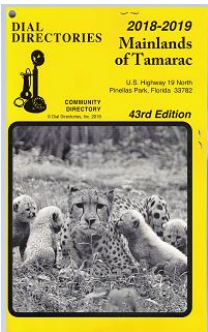
Spring is in the air and people have decided to purchase a home at the Mainlands in Unit 2! It's always fun to meet and greet our new neighbors.

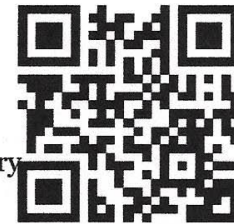

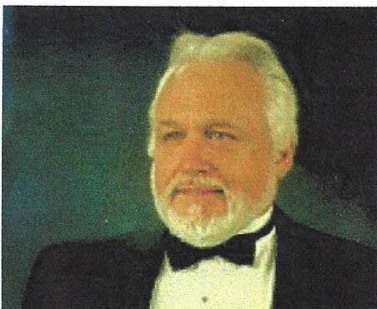

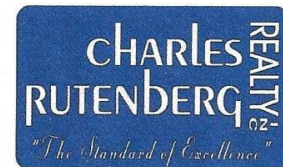
