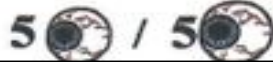

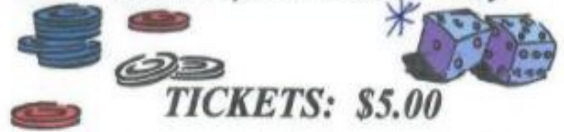

LIBRARY NEWS

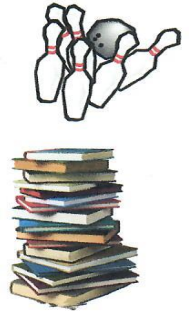
