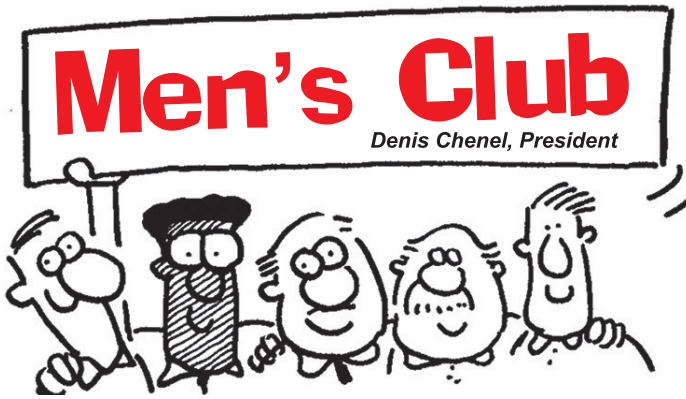

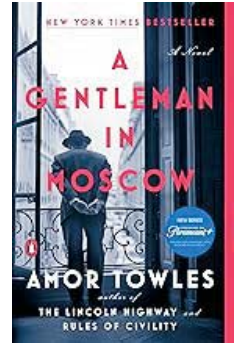
## Join the Book Club!

## ***How to Have a Celebration of Life Mainlands in Unit 2***

Mainlands Unit 2 is so sorry when our neighbors pass. Mainlands is one happy family and a neighbors loss leaves a void. Families of Mainlands residents may have their *Celebration Of Life* at the clubhouse at no cost to use the hall. Below is a brief list of what is provided at no charge. In addition, we can provide a generic Celebration outline if needed. Hall tables are preset and cannot be moved. Hall must be returned in the order it was received or there will be a damage and clean-up fee.

There will be one Mainlands contact person for the event. Mainlands requires the Celebration provide Mainlands one event contact person. A brief outline is below. A detailed outline will be provided upon securing the hall. Using the Mainlands Unit 2 clubhouse is like renting any other venue for an event. You are renting the room only. The event provides all other items.

Mainlands provides no food or drink, but will announce the event at coffee and ask for food donations. The event planner should provide a phone number to text food plans.

### **Mainlands provides at no charge:**

- The Hall along with tables and chairs
- Five rows of tables containing 4 six foot tables. Each row seats 24
- Three round tables seating 6 each. One 4 foot table at the door.
- Use of refrigerators and stoves (Must be clean at conclusion of event).
- Slide show screen only, Microphone, Podium

### **Mainlands does not provide**

- Set-up or clean-up
- AV equipment or Music System
- Kitchen supplies including spoons, plates, silverware, hot mats for counter serving pieces, etc.
- Coffee Machines
- Cleaning supplies including paper towel, tea towels, garbage bags or cleaning solutions
- Food or condiments or food servers
- No liquor allowed

# DO YOU KNOW YOUR MODEL?

(continued)

To continue our model review from last month, there were four other models included in the original 1969 Mainlands' Brochure for Unit 2. Pictures of these models are included in this article. The Essex you will recognize. We have discussed that model in detail in previous articles. The Essex became The Eden; and is the model for which we have the most information.

However there were three other models included in the original brochure: The Fairfax, The Westchester, and The Devon.

Do you recognize the layout of any of these models? As a result, do you know the name of the models today? One of these three models is very common in Unit 2. It originally came with a carport and we have featured it before. You will notice the differences in costs for additions to the models. It is interesting that Central Air Conditioning

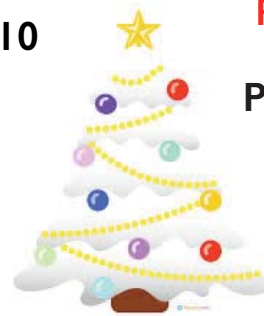

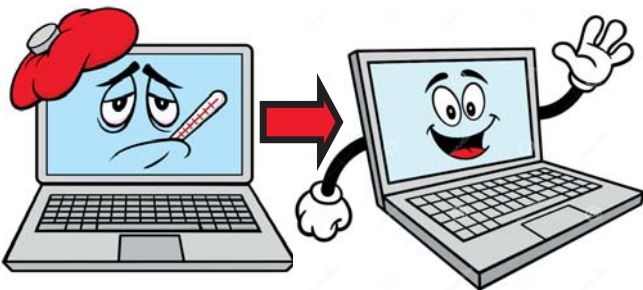
