## A Good Time Was Had by ALL

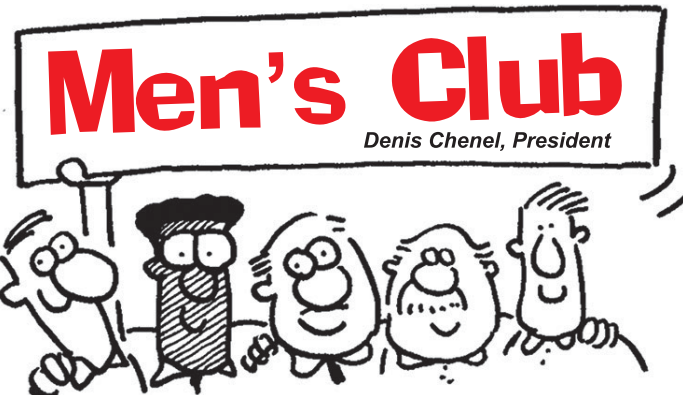

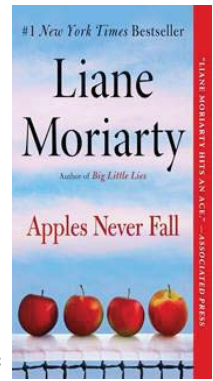
# Join the Book Club!

## What did your money buy in 1969?

When Mainlands started in 1969 there were lists of “Custom” Features on each house flyer. The attached list of Custom Features was the same for all houses except the Winchester. Towards the bottom of the list, note that the houses came without Washers and Dryers. There were just ‘Built-in Outlets for Automatic Washer and Electric Dyer Outlet.’ I have been told you got an outdoor retractable clothes line.

Premium features such as Wall-to-Wall carpet were designed to increase sales. In the 60s Wall to Wall Carpet was the “In” thing. Many of my parents’ friends covered up beautiful real hardwood floors with “Wall-to-wall” carpet. So it is logical that carpet was a selling point. But, why was an “Oven & Range with Hood” a selling point? Doesn’t every house need a stove?

Also notice the costs of additions. In the Amherst which is the Abby, there is only a \$300 difference between a carport and a garage. Why would you get a carport? But adding Central Air was \$995. That was a lot in 1969. Central AC for all the other models, despite size was \$1095. Also some models did not offer the same addition options, possibly due to lot size or house design. We do not know.

Enjoy looking at these additional house options. It is fun to see what additions houses on your street enjoy. But don’t even think about the FLORIDA Rooms or screened porches. That was a whole other story.

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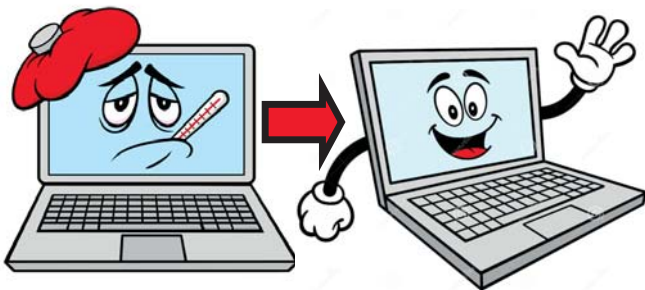
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
