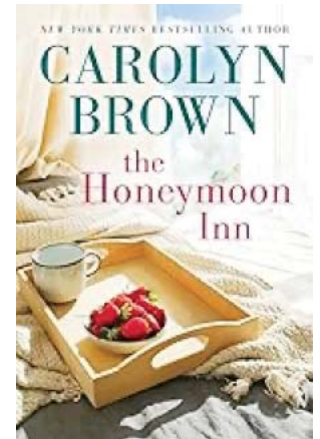


advertisement from when her house was purchased.
