*We held our required HOA meeting on March 16, 2026.*

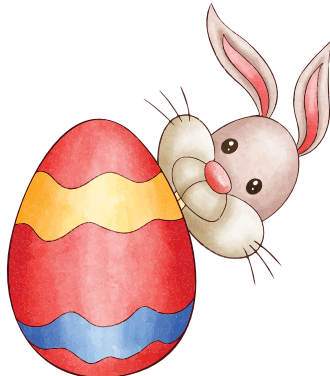
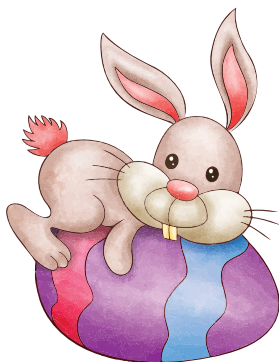
*I am sorry to report that we have lost residents, Elmer "Fitz" Fitzgerald, and Rhonda Nivans in March. Our sympathies to their families.*

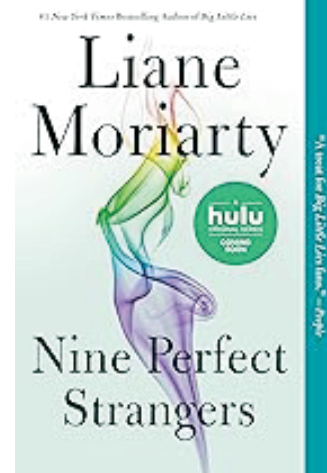

Please contact Kathleen Tremblay before depositing a large quantity of books to the library. We want to make sure we have plenty of room for those books.

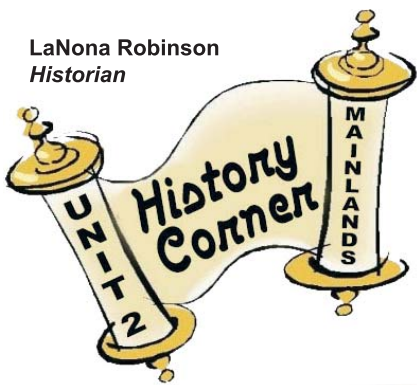

# The Baldwin... is it one or is it two bathrooms?

I found a copy of the original Ad for the Baldwin with layout and front elevation. Notice in 1971 the cost was \$14,990 with one bath and an additional \$1095 for two baths. Two baths took away the Master Bedroom walk in closet and bumped out the back wall to add a closet.

There were three general front designs for the original price, but there is an interesting increase in price for the front design series 330. It cost \$15,785. But why? The advertisement does not provide the cost increase for this front design.

Did you pay \$795 extra for the gray decorator area paint in #330? Was this version even built in Pinellas Park? Plus, the ad shows #330 with a gray roof not white. We know the original builders used the same advertising materials in Miami Mainlands and Pinellas

# ST. PATRICK'S DAY DINNER

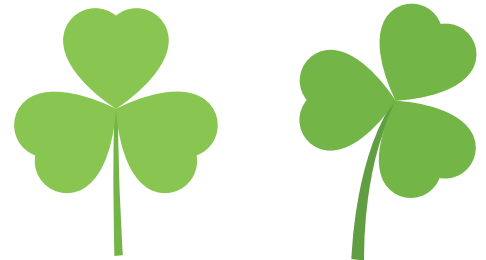

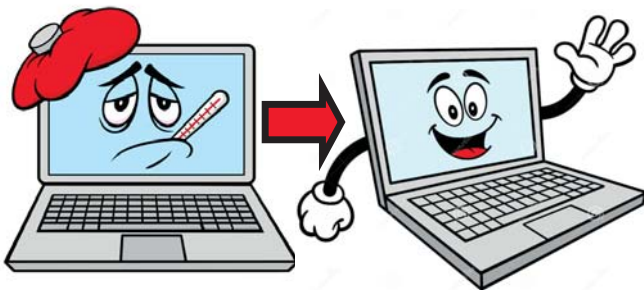

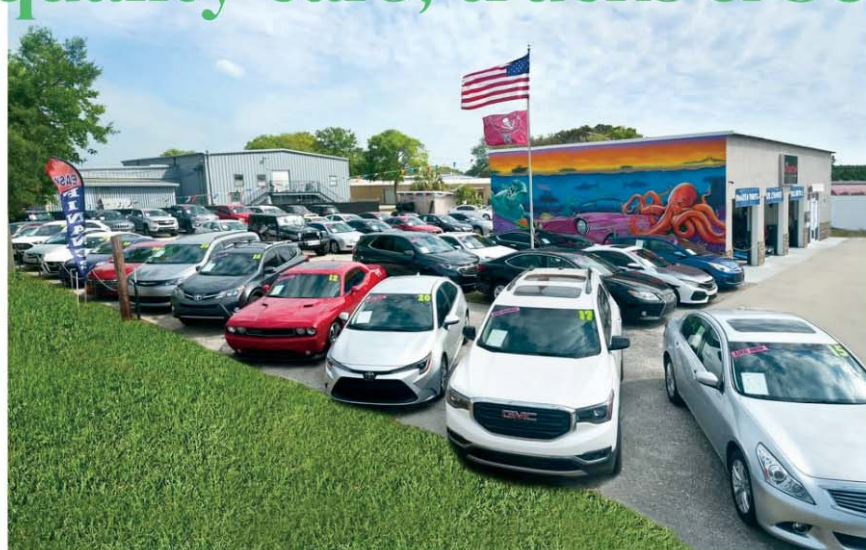
