

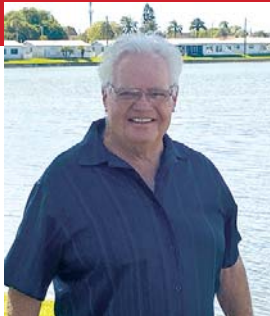

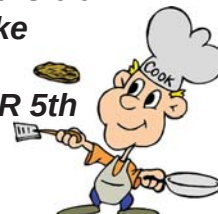

■ Go home? We never think of it — don't miss the kids either — they come to see us. They like it that way —

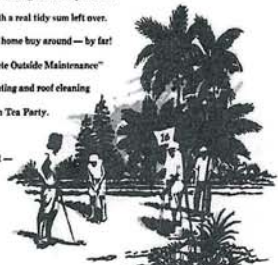
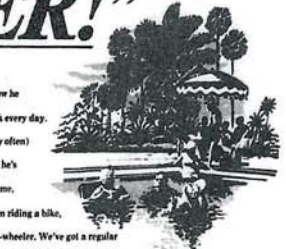
think there's nothing like Florida. ■ William is forever bending someone's ear about how he sold out back east and got all set up here in

Office use - please use the office door.



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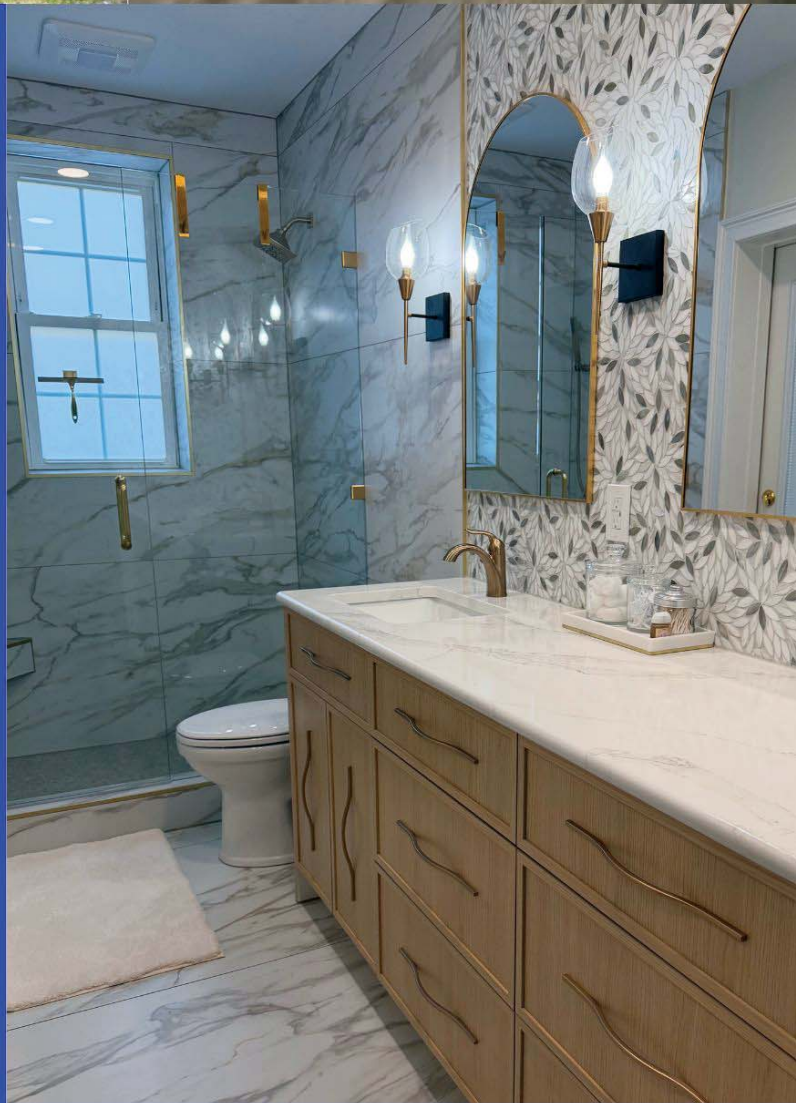
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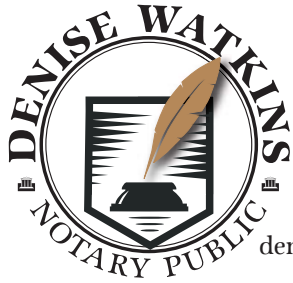
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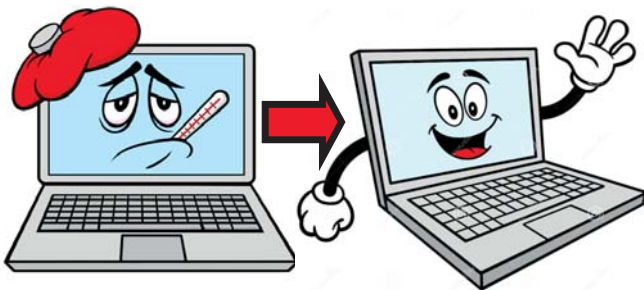
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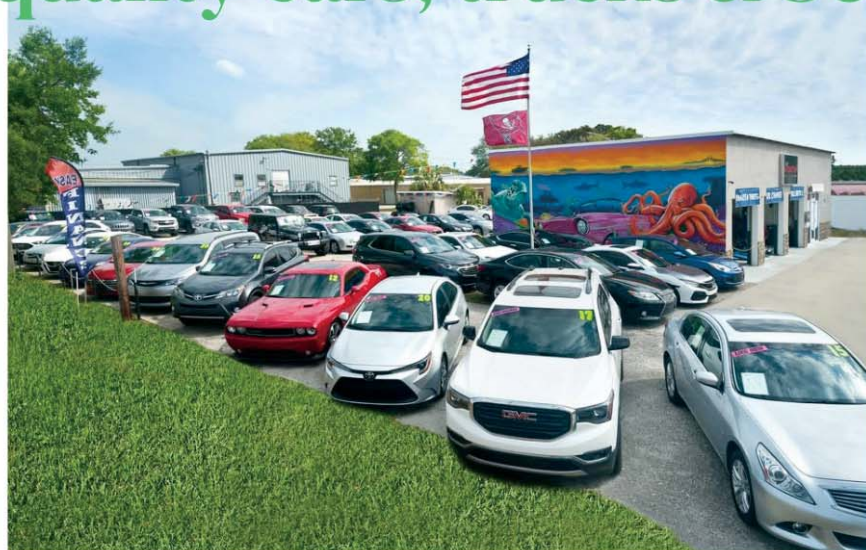
