Pinellas Park is under District Phase I water shortage until July 1, 2026. The office will continue to ensure our sprinkler watering schedule meets local and district requirements and the specific needs of the community. Residents are also asked to report any suspected problems with their sprinklers to the Office to ensure they are working properly. Limited hand-watering of plants (i.e., bushes, flowers) is allowed. Be aware that overwatering could lead to excessive weed or fungus growth. No watering during or after a rain or sprinkler watering is allowed between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Along with the fun, we have also been faced with serious business. Unfortunately, the terms of all the Social Club Board members expire in April. The Bylaws state there should be staggered elections yearly, with three members elected on even years and four elected on odd years. For at least the last four years, there has not been a need for an election since no more than one person volunteered for each position. In fact, many Board members remained in their position so the Social Club Board could continue.

Your Social Club Board is allowed to make a one-time adjustment to the Bylaws. This is the adjustment: "In order to get back to the staggered election of officers and directors as written in Article 4.B of the Social Club Constitution, the terms of two officers and one director position will be for one year. At the Social Club Board Meeting following the election, the Social Club Board shall determine which two officers and director have one year terms."

2026 is a different year! Kathi Meale was appointed to the Nominating Committee. She has been successful in recruiting residents to run for your Social Club Board. Voting shall be by secret ballot if the number of nominees exceeds the number of openings. All residents of Unit 3 are members of the Social Club, allowed to run for office, and vote.

Job descriptions for each position can be found in the Social Club Bylaws online at www.themainlands.com, Unit 3, Social Club. A copy will also be posted on the bulletin board in the Clubhouse. Please feel free to talk to any of the current Board members if you have any questions.

Don't be anxious about volunteering. We were all new to the Board at one point but working together with fellow residents and friends is rewarding. We need new ideas and opinions.

Nomination forms are available from Kathi Meale at (727)800-5524 or in the Clubhouse. A nomination form must be completed and signed by the nominee. **Nominations are due by February 6, 2026.** Voting is in March and installation is in April.

Once the slate of officers/directors is complete, voting by secret ballot will be at the Social Club General Meeting on Thursday, March 12, 2026 at 9:30 am. You may also request an absentee ballot by contacting Jill Keating at (678)758-8086. **All absentee ballots must be received by Thursday, March 12, 2026 at 9:30 am.**

The ballot box will be in the Clubhouse starting February 7.

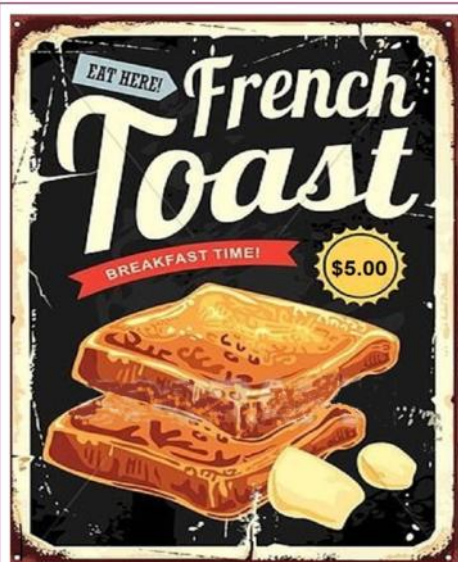

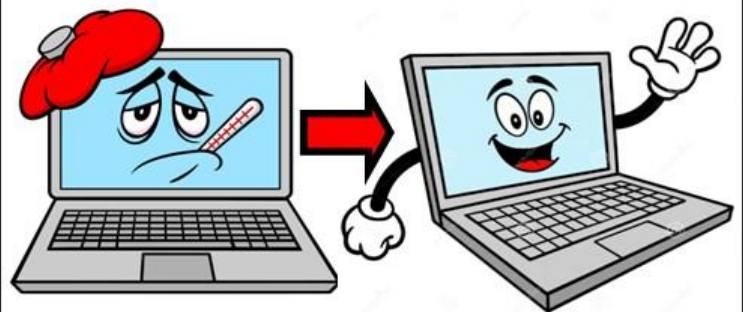

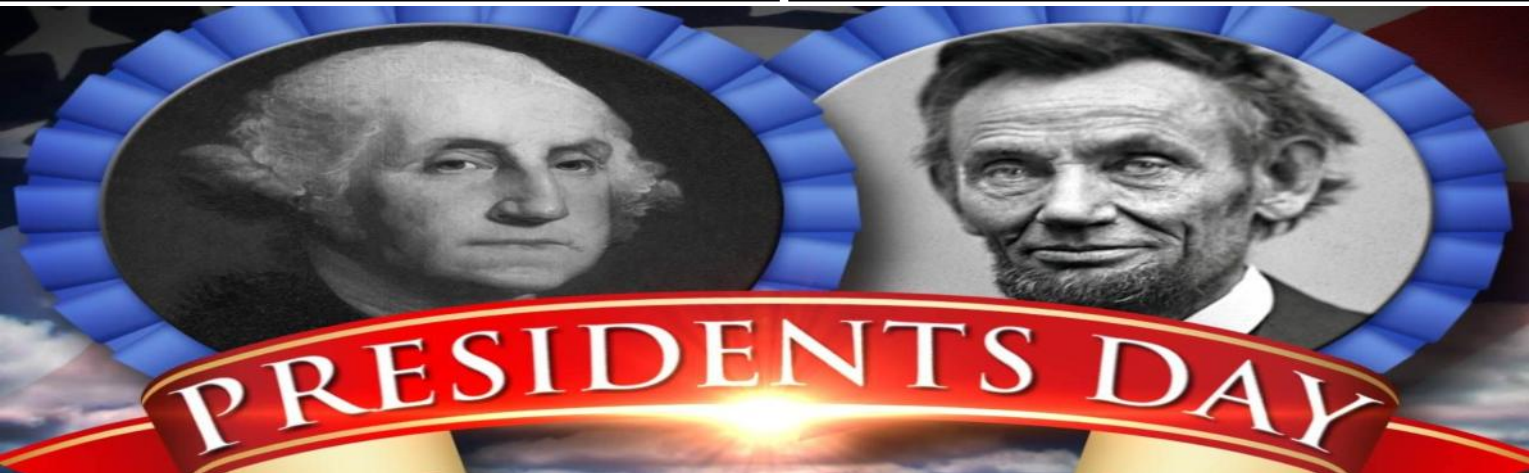
