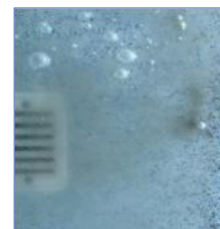
Monthly Pool Cleaning Schedule

To ensure the pool remains in top condition, a new cleaning schedule will begin May 23, 2026. The pool will be closed on the third Tuesday of each month from 7:00 to 9:30 a.m. for a thorough cleaning. Please plan your swimming sessions accordingly.

Showering Before Swimming: Why It Matters

Showering before entering the pool is more important than many realize, especially after applying sunscreen. Oils from sunscreen that aren't rinsed off can settle on the water's surface, leading to residue and potential maintenance issues. Below is a picture illustrating how these oils accumulate when swimmers skip showering after applying sunscreen.

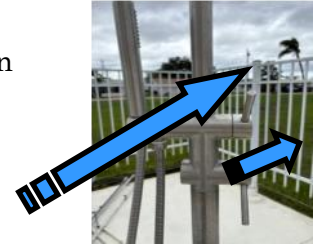
How to Use the Pool Shower

To operate the shower:

- To turn on the shower, pull the lever of the bottom handle outward
- If you prefer the handheld shower, make sure the top handle is facing toward the pool
- When the top handle is turned toward the fence, the main overhead shower will work
- To adjust the water temperature, turn the bottom handle towards the pool for hot and towards the fence for cold

It is that time of the year as the weather starts to shift to higher temperatures. The Snowbirds begin to head north and folks start prepping their homes for the next Hurricane Season, which begins in 31 days and will be upon us before you know it. For Snowbirds, please check the outside of your homes making sure things are secure and store any loose articles that could become airborne in a storm. Please arrange with a neighbor to check your home and contact you in an emergency. Please get an Alterations Permit from the office for any repairs being done on the outside of your home. This includes trimming of trees over 20 feet high, gutters, doors, windows, air conditioners, patios, and garage doors. If you are not sure, please call the office or contact me. For the period of March 20 to April 20, there were 22 Alteration Requests.

Annual mole cricket granule systemic treatment is scheduled for April 30. As of April 3, a Modified Phase III "Extreme" Water Shortage Order is in effect due to severe drought and declining water supplies and, restricting, as shown on the Pinellas County News page, all water sources (potable, well, reclaimed) to one day per week. Outdoor water use accounts for more than 50% of water consumed by households and residents. To protect the remaining water supply, Pinellas County Utilities staff is authorized to issue fines for violations of the watering restrictions.

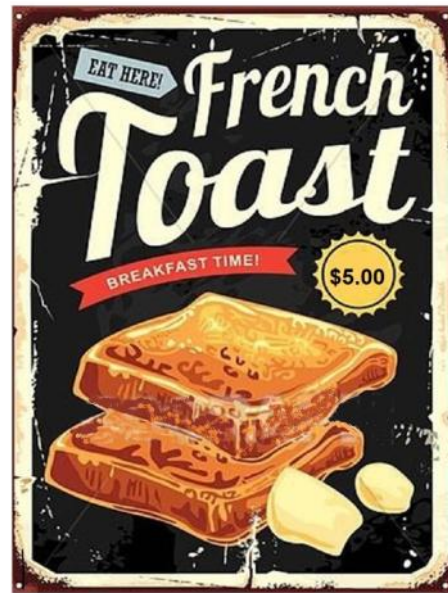

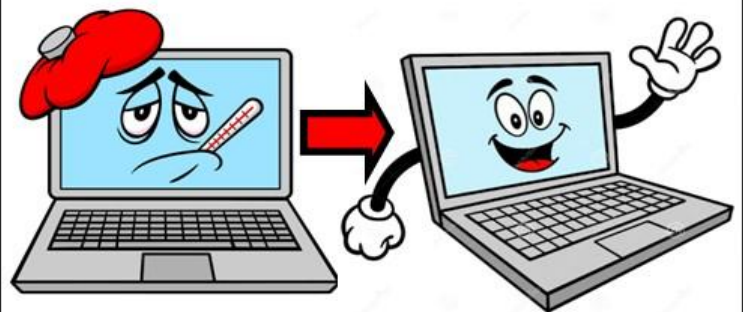
