A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

To: All Unit #3 Homeowners

If you vote “Yes,” a vote to waive the Fully Funded Budget, the proposed Partially Funded Budget will go into effect and the following maintenance fees would apply, effective January 1, 2027:

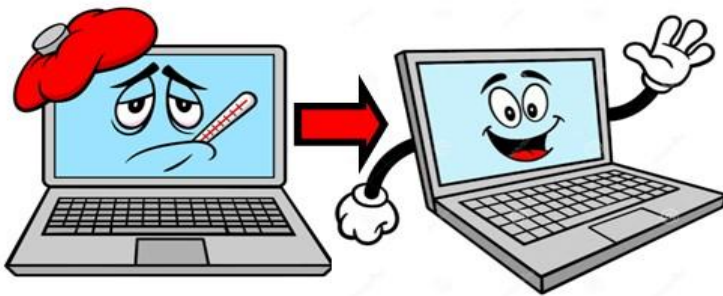

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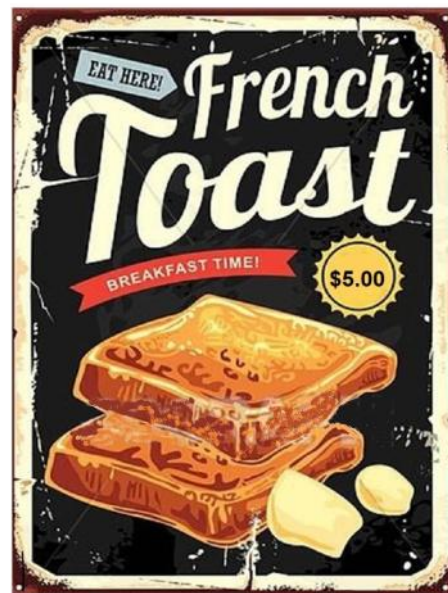

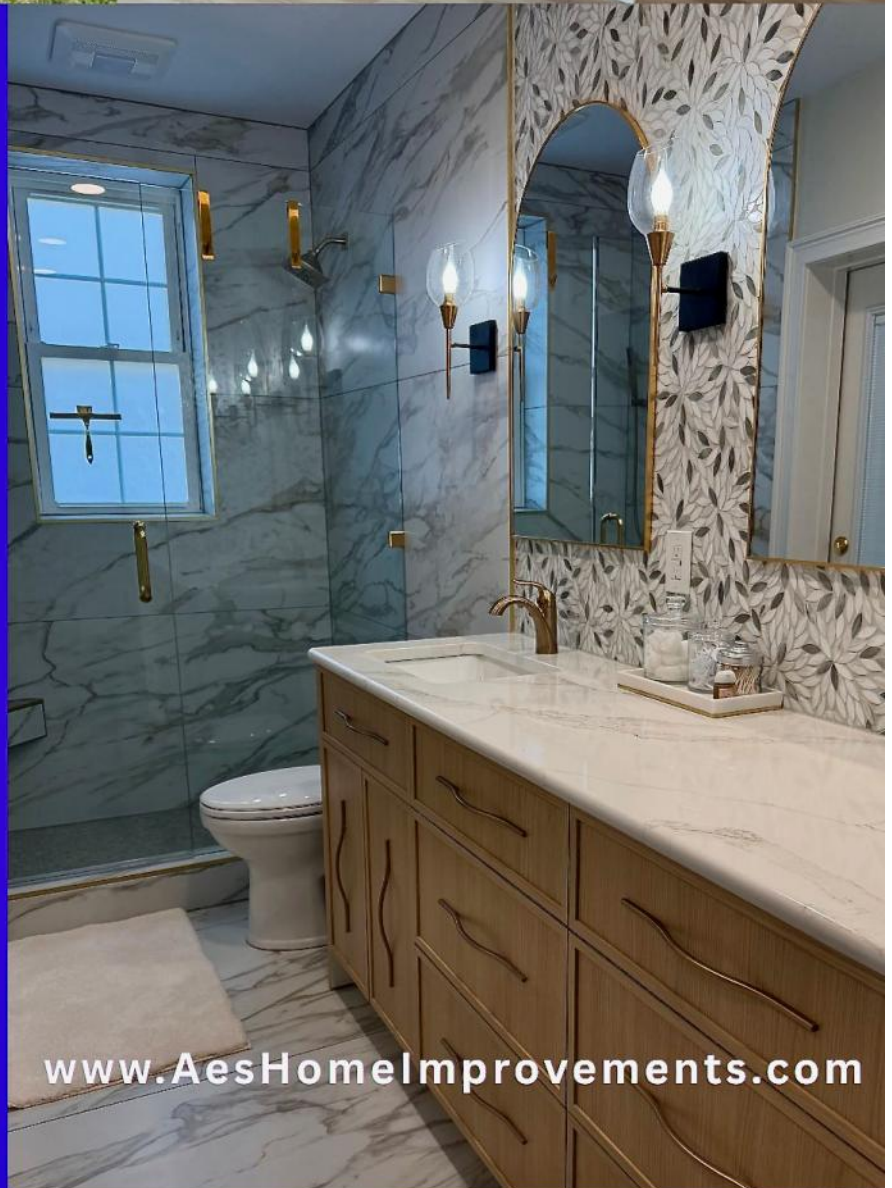
