

#### News from the Board:

Hello Everyone!

The summer is just about over, and our northern neighbors will be starting their southern migration soon. Our Homeowner's Board of Directors will be having their monthly meetings once again along with the Women's Club and Men's Club. This month's Board of Directors meeting will be Thursday, September 4 at 6:30 p.m. By now you should have received a mailing announcing our annual meeting which is coming up in October. In this packet you will also find an "intent to run for the Board." There are four seats up for election or reelection. At this time, I believe all four Board members currently occupying those seats intend to run again. Of course, this is your opportunity to run for the Board, which is a two-year commitment. I encourage anyone interested in running for the Board to complete the form and turn it in.

On August 21 we had the Homeowner's Budget and Answer meeting. Ken Krywanek our treasurer went over the budget and homeowners had the opportunity to ask questions. Due to the increase cost in roofs, paint, lawn maintenance and insurance cost we had no choice but to raise the HOA fees this year. The budget for next year will be on the agenda for the September meeting when a vote will be held to approve it.

I have received a couple of calls in regard to someone exercising on the shuffleboard courts. One of the reports was a person seen jumping rope. *The shuffleboard courts are only to be used for playing shuffleboard and nothing else.* Even when they are used for shuffleboard one should avoid walking on the courts so they don't get damaged.

Parking has continued to be an issue for which I get complaints on occasion. Please remember there is no parking on our streets overnight. There is no parking on lawns or sidewalks and no commercial vehicles. If you have overnight guest and you cannot fit the vehicle in your garage or driveway, parking passes can be obtained at the Mainlands' office, or if it is on a weekend or holiday a Board member can issue a pass for the clubhouse lot on 98<sup>th</sup> Terrace next to the shuffleboard courts.

I look forward to seeing everyone at the upcoming meeting and other events.

#### TIME TO PAINT THE HOUSES!!



If we do not hear from you by September 3<sup>rd</sup>, your house shutters will be painted the <u>same</u> color, your front door will be painted, your garage door will be painted and your awnings will be washed but not painted.

Anyone choosing a color NOT included on this form should submit an "Exterior Alteration Request" form for approval.


