On January 14th, 1969, on his television show, Richard Bernard "Red" Skelton told a story about one of his teachers from when he was in elementary school. The teacher noticed as the school year had progressed, the students seemed to be just going through the motions of saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the U. S. flag, so the teacher reminded the students of the importance of the words by defining for them what each one meant. Below is an excerpt from the rendition that Red Skelton gave:

I - "Me, an individual, a committee of one."

***Pledge** - "Dedicate all of my worldly goods to give without self-pity."*

***Allegiance** - "My love and my devotion."*

***To the flag** - "'Our standard, Old Glory, a symbol of freedom. Wherever she waves, there's respect because your loyalty has given her a dignity that shouts freedom is everybody's job!"*

***of the United** - "That means that we have all come together."*

***States** - "Individual communities that have united into forty-eight great states. Forty-eight individual communities with pride and dignity and purpose; all divided with imaginary boundaries, yet united to a common purpose, and that's love for the entire country."*

***And to the Republic** - "Republic. A state in which sovereign power is invested in representatives chosen by the people to govern. And government is the people and it's from the people to the leaders, not from the leaders to the people"*

***For which it stands, One Nation under God** - "One Nation, meaning "all 48, each, blessed by God"*

***Indivisible** - "Incapable of being divided."*

***With liberty** - "Which is freedom -- the right of power to live one's own life without threats, fear or some sort of retaliation."*

***And Justice** - "The principle or quality of dealing fairly (no favoritism) with others."*

***For all.** - "For All means, boys and girls, it's as much your country as it is mine."*

Whether reciting the Pledge of Allegiance on the celebration of our nation's independence or reciting ritual in a masonic lodge the meaning of words must be understood to have importance.

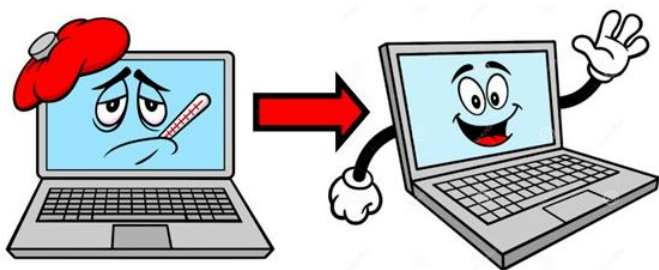

How should I treat the flag?

- Always treat her with respect. Never throw the USA flag on the ground, floor or into the water.
- Display her with the union (blue field w/stars) at the top to the observer's left.
- Illuminate her if flown after sunset. If she's not an "All Weather" flag, she should not be displayed in bad weather.
- Raise the flag briskly and lower her slowly, ceremoniously.
- When she's worn out, faded, or torn, she should be retired in a dignified way.

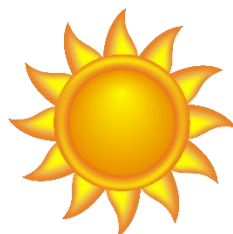

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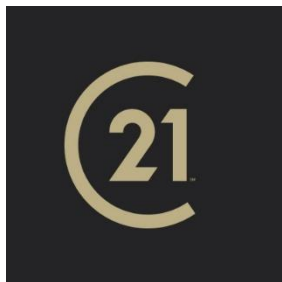
- How much you'll need to retire

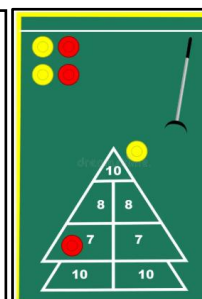

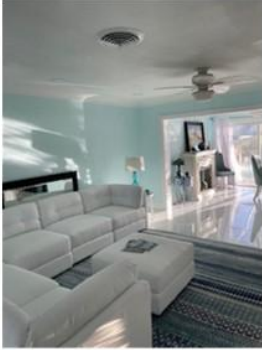

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TIME TO PAINT HOUSES!!

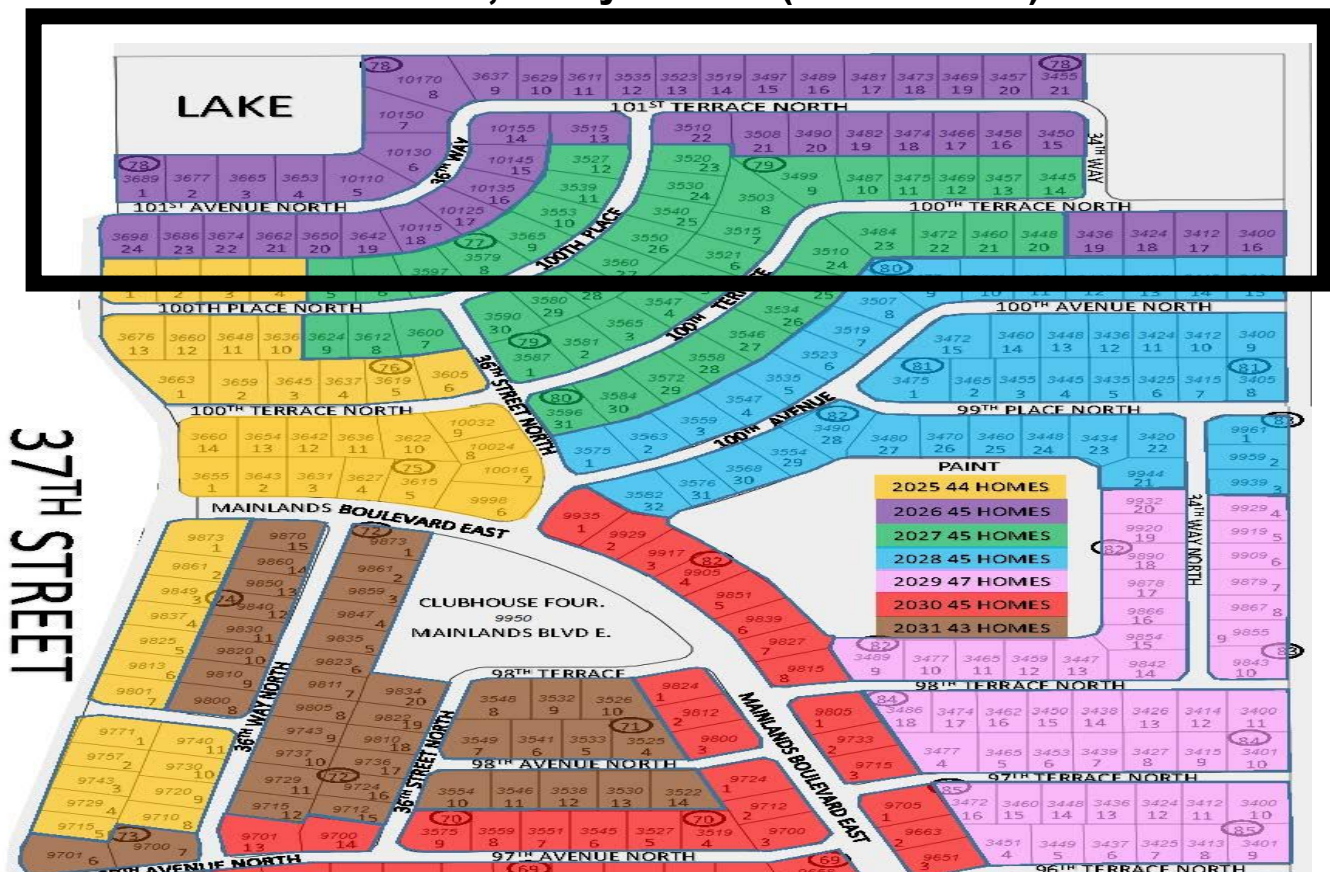
This year we will be painting the houses highlighted in **PURPLE** as shown on the paint chart below (and located in the Unit 4 Clubhouse). Pressure washing and painting of these houses are *scheduled to begin Monday, September 14, 2026*.

Homeowners in this area should have received from the office an instruction form which shows the approved shutter colors. **Please complete this form and return it to me ASAP even if you have no changes.** All forms need to be returned to me no later than Tuesday, September 1ST. If you have any special instructions, you may include them on this form.

If we do not hear from you by September 1ST, your house shutters will be painted the same color, your front door will be painted, your garage door will be painted and your awnings will be washed but not painted.

Anyone choosing a color NOT included on this form should submit an "Exterior Alteration Request" form for approval.

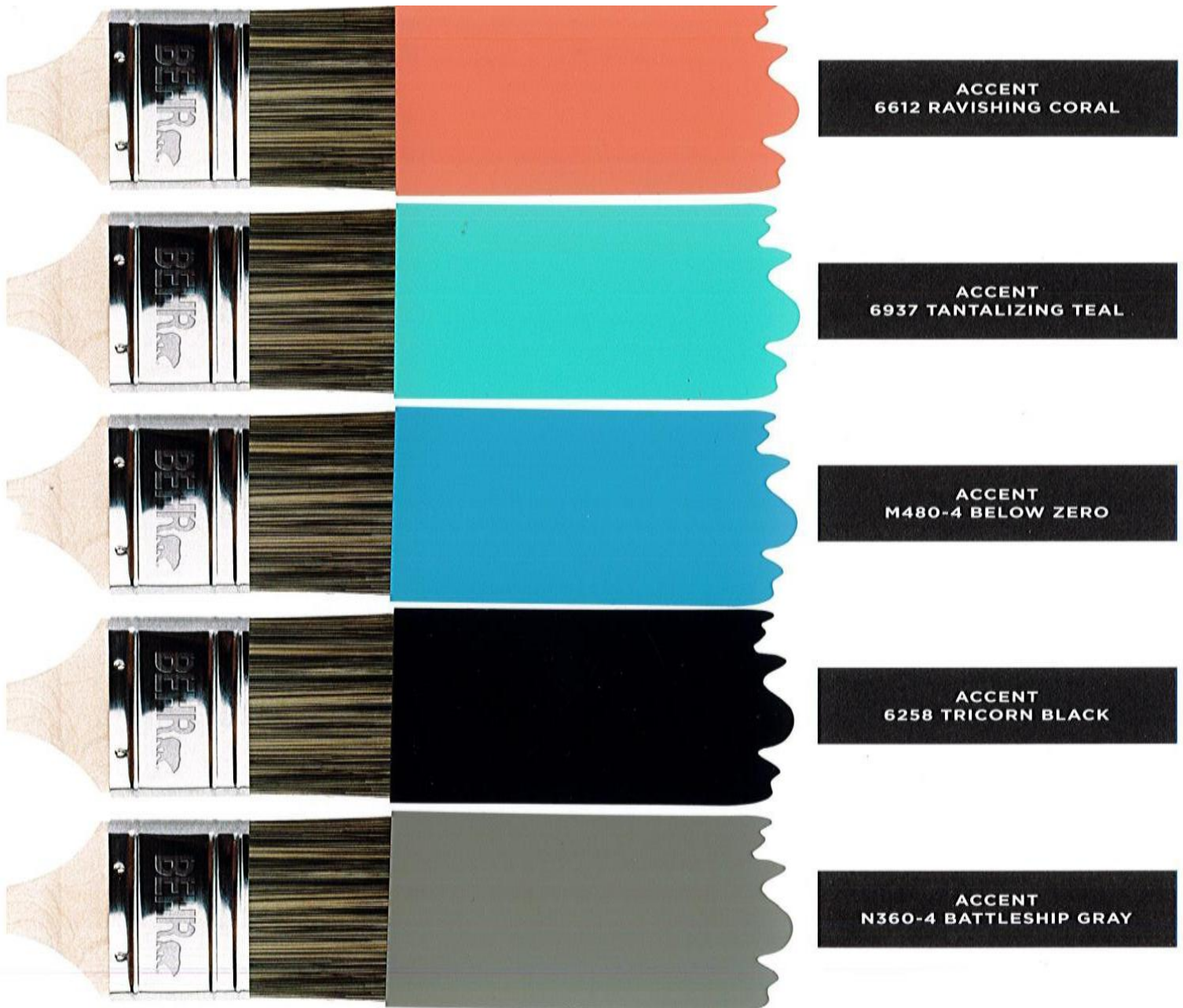
