News from the Board

Ahhh...October has arrived and cooler days will soon be here. With the start of the fall season, our snow bird friends have started to come back and the clubhouse is hopping once more with lots of activities. I hope you are enjoying these events and helping out when you can, because without volunteers this place would be boring and we don't want that.

On September 3, we had our first Board of Directors meeting with 33 residents attending. The Board approved the 2027 Budget, which means our HOA dues will be going up to \$500 a month starting in January, 2027. The Board approved the change to Section 9 of the Construction code regarding retractable awnings. Another approved motion was to add a membership vote to the annual meeting for an addendum to the Declaration of Condominium that prohibits ownership by corporations or other similar entities (as worded by association legal counsel). This proposed addendum will prevent corporations from buying up numerous properties so they have the votes necessary to change our community. The last motion was to remove the replacement or repair of private driveways from the construction code; this motion failed.

By now, you should have received the second mailing for the Annual Meeting which contains the agenda and advises of other important information. There are three director positions open this year. Scott and Nancy submitted their candidate forms and we had one other resident submit a form. Since there are three openings and three applicants, there will be no election this year for directors. We still need you to vote on reserves, the rollover of excess operating funds, and the proposed changes to our Documents. Please submit your votes as soon as possible or vote in person on October 22. If you have any questions, feel free to call the office or me.

Don't forget the Board of Directors meeting on October 1. The Unit 4 breakfast will be October 10, and the Annual Meeting will be October 22. Hope to see many of you at these events!

Some interesting facts about Halloween:

- **Ancient Origins:** Halloween began as Samhain, a Celtic festival marking the end of the harvest and the start of winter.
- **Orange and Black:** The classic Halloween colors represent the fall harvest (orange) and the darkness of winter (death and the supernatural veil).
- **Turnip Lanterns:** The first jack-o'-lanterns were carved from turnips, beets, and potatoes, not pumpkins.
- **Stingy Jack:** The name "jack-o'-lantern" comes from an Irish folktale about a man named Stingy Jack who was doomed to wander the earth with a burning coal inside a carved turnip.
- **Michael Myers' Mask:** The scary mask worn by Michael Myers in the 1978 horror movie *Halloween* is actually a recycled, painted Captain James Kirk mask from *Star Trek* bought for \$2.
- **Houdini's Death:** The famous illusionist Harry Houdini died on Halloween night in 1926, adding to his mysterious legacy.
- **Full Moons are Rare:** On average, a full moon on Halloween only happens every 19 years.
- **Wise Witches:** The word "witch" comes from the Old English word *wicce*, which originally meant "wise woman" rather than an evil sorceress.
- **Bats in a Cauldron:** A group or cluster of bats is officially called a "cauldron".
- **Mischief Night:** October 30th is known as Mischief Night, an evening of minor pranks that originally began to confuse wandering spirits.
- **2nd Biggest Commercial Holiday:** Halloween is the second-largest commercial gift and party holiday in the United States, right after Christmas.





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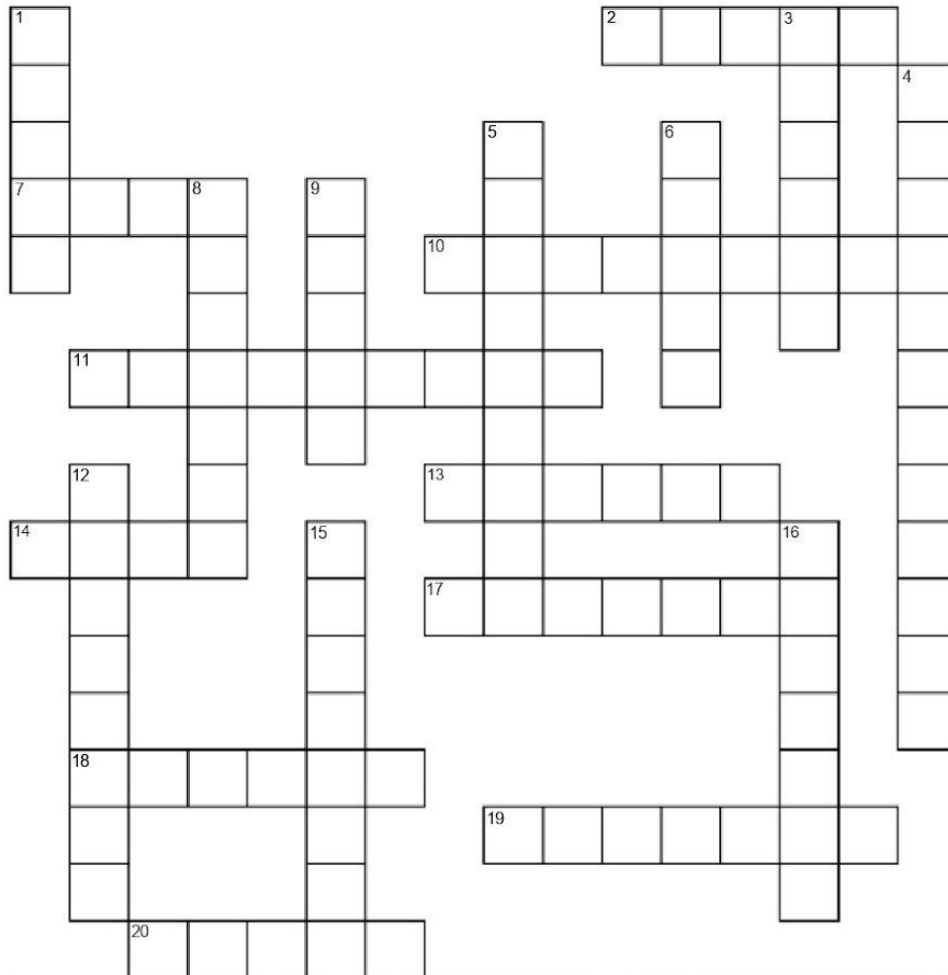

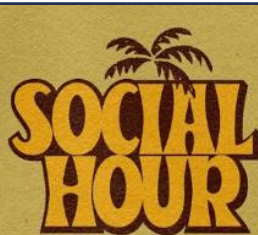
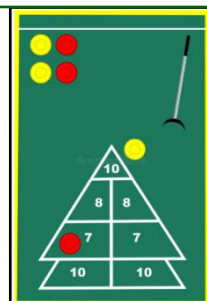
