Sewers Sanitary Lines Emergency Cleanings, and Repairs

1. GA Nichols – A Motion of Emergency Jet Vac, Cleaning Common Use 8" clay pipe sanitary sewer line for Unit 5/6 for \$10,880.00-Invoice 25-0519#1F

Clean excess sand/grit sediment found during repair process, full cleaning of 2600 Linear feet common use mainline shared between units 5/6 plus a dump fee, breakdown fees:

Two laurel oak trees near the northwest corner of the property- Elevate the drip lines, center prune, remove the broken limbs and remove the standard sized dead limbs. Laurel oak tree near the northeast corner of the property- Elevate the drip line, center prune, remove the broken limbs and remove the standard sized dead limbs. Laurel oak tree near the southeast corner of the property- Elevate the drip line, center prune, remove the broken limbs and remove the standard sized dead limbs. Trim the 4 washingtonia palms on this property and cut out the seed pods. Trim the 2 queen palms on this property and cut out the seed pods. Trim the 3 date palms on this property and cut out the seed pods. Trim the 3 triple robellini palms on this property and cut out the seed pods. The debris will be removed.

General Disclaimer (Specifications and exclusions - not applicable to every job):

If your quote includes deadwooding:

Standard deadwood removal is for completely dead limbs 3" inches in diameter and larger. "Larger deadwood" is completely dead and greater than 4" inches in diameter.

If your quote includes stump grinding:
We can't be responsible for items in the ground.

Grinder can only grind to 5" inches from walkways and 12" inches from structures, walls, fenceposts, etc.. Foundation footer is 12" from wall, so we cannot grind within 17" inches of structures with a foundation. If we are required, and agree, to get closer than this, we cannot be held responsible for incidental damage.

Standard grind 4" - 6" inches below where root flare meets soil. The root flare may connect to the soil well above general grade. And surface grind roots so there is nothing to trip on.

Due to logistical constraints, trees that are to be removed, may not be able to be ground on the same day as service.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS OF MAINLANDS OF TAMARAC BY THE GULF UNIT FIVE ASSOCIATION, INC.

Proposed amendment to ARTICLE VII of the By-Laws of Mainlands of Tamarac by the Gulf Unit Five Association, Inc., to add a new Section 3, to read as follows:

ARTICLE VII Finances

Section 3. The Board will follow the following financial management guidelines:

- A. Certificates of Deposit ("CDs") backed by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation ("FDIC") are acceptable for investment.
- B. United States Treasury instruments, a direct obligation of the United States government, are acceptable for investment.
- C. CDs and United States Treasury instruments must be "laddered" so they are always maturing to capture future opportunities.
- <u>D. Two signatures the President and Treasurer are always required on the Stifel</u> account or the Association's current investment account.
- E. Signatures must be updated each time a new President and/or Treasurer are elected or appointed.
- F. The Association's Property Management will continue to notify the appropriate Board member of pending invoices in that Board member's area of supervision/responsibility.
