I hope everyone had a great holiday and a Happy New Year.

I would like to start off by saying “Please do not deface the Clubhouse”. Someone put a political sticker from 50 years ago in the urinal of the men’s room. We could not get it off. I had to call Joe at the Office and his workers removed it for us. Not only was this uncalled for, but we had to pay to have it removed. Please, we are doing our best to make our Clubhouse look great and updated. So, I ask that this not happen again.

We received a quote for the lock on the front door of the clubhouse. The quote is \$4,386.11. I have asked all of us to treat this clubhouse as if it was your own home. If you are the last one here, please make sure the doors are locked. Even though there is security in the evening, the doors should not be left unlocked during the day for a stranger to enter. This has happened in the past. Lately the kitchen door has been left unlocked more than once. If a resident comes in the clubhouse alone, we do not want them to be hurt. So we ask that you be responsible and make sure all doors are locked. We are trying to keep our cost down so we can keep our fees as they are. This is up to all of us.

The floors in the clubhouse will be refinished on March 25th thru March 28th. We have to stay off the floors for 3 full days. You can go into the patio area **only**. Please stay off the floors until the Board removes the barriers. If you need to use the facilities, use your fob from the outside.

The fire hydrants will be replaced and water will have to be turned off. You will receive a robo call ahead of time and you will be given instructions. Make sure the Maintenance office has your phone number to give you a robo call when this is happening.

Our next meeting will be March 10th at 7pm.

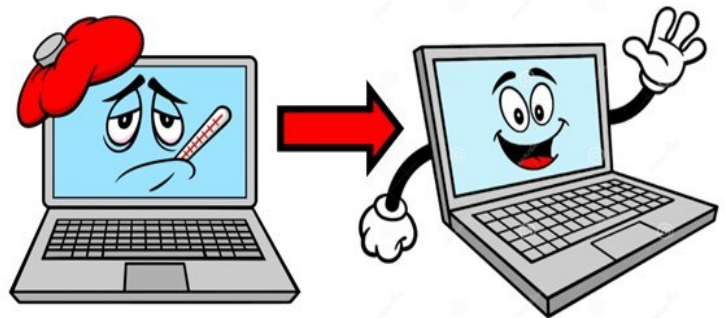

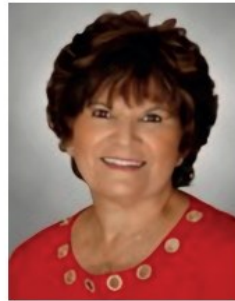
